Registration Fee: All students must apply for enrollment each year. There is no family discount for the registration fee and it is non-refundable once the applicant has been enrolled into The Academy.

*Exception: military families with proof of orders.

Included in the Registration fee: Processing fee, student accident insurance, and Ordinariate fees.

Items not part of the registration fee include, but are not limited to:

- Textbooks. They are the responsibility of families and are the property of the students. An online system for purchasing books is available with a vendor, and it is the responsibility of our families to purchase needed items. Books may be purchased new or used (when available), from this vendor or others. Certain consumables (e.g. student planner) must be purchased through the school.
- School uniforms.
- Classroom or grade-based field trips.
- Individual membership dues in the Junior and National Honor Society.
- Athletic and club fees.
- Before- and After-school care.
- Advanced Placement testing costs for upper school students.
- FACTS SIS (formerly RenWeb) new student application fee.
- Annual yearbook.

Late Fee: If paying on a monthly basis, a late fee of \$100 will be applied to your account for any tuition payments received after the first business day of the month.

Tuition Payment: Families not receiving financial aid that elect to pay the tuition in full when registering on FACTS will receive a \$200 discount per student. Families not receiving financial aid that elect to pay by semester will receive a \$50 discount per semester per student. Families may also elect to pay tuition on a monthly basis. Typically, tuition is divided into 11 monthly payments starting June 1st and ending on April 1st of the following year. Tuition payments are collected by FACTS on the first business day of the month. The 11-month tuition payment will be \$800 per month, minus the reduced rate for qualifying students for in-parish tuition.

Financial Assistance: Aid may be provided to families that demonstrate financial need. A family requesting financial aid must submit an application through the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment service (<https://online.factsmgt.com/AID>). Our FACTS Institution ID# is: **24432**

Deadline for Financial Aid: April 1, 2020

In-Parish Tuition: Families must be registered members of Our Lady of the Atonement Catholic Church and tithe a minimum of \$50 per month for a 12 month period to qualify for this lower rate. Parish status for current students will be determined based on the previous 12 month contributions. If you have questions about your status, please contact the Business Office during regular hours.

Criteria for qualification:

- A minimum of \$600 must be in your family parish account by June (for the previous 12 month) for a family to qualify for the in-parish rate for the upcoming year, otherwise out of parish rates will apply.
- If a family leaves the parish or is no longer contributing at least \$50 per month, they will lose their in parish rate and out of parish rate will apply.
- Please note that tithing must be accountable; therefore, the use of checks, tithing envelopes, or credit/debit cards is highly encouraged.
- Tithing does not include donations made to special events hosted by the church or school, purchase of merchandise, goods or services, raffle ticket purchases, capital campaign fundraisers, or any special collection.
- New parents must register with the parish and must begin tithing a minimum of \$50 per month from the point of entry and going forward.
- In-parish tuition will also apply to all active members of the military.
